# Meeting Minutes Case-Halstead Library Board of Trustees Monday, Jan. 4, 2016

Meeting Location: Conference Room, Library, 550 Sixth Street, Carlyle, IL 62231

**Board Members Present:** Barb Guebert-President, Brenda Johnson-City Liaison, Jane Bullock-Treasurer, Ken O'Dell, Darren Tracy, Kim Wilkerson, Frank Buckingham, Kim Stamps

**Absent:** Kim Stamps—Vice President (excused), Michelle Scott—Secretary (excused), Christi Gerrish-Library Director (excused)

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m., and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

## **Meeting Minutes:**

There was a brief follow-up of last month's minutes.

- -Motion: Darren made a motion to accept the Dec. 7 meeting minutes.
- -Second: Kim Wilkerson seconded.
- -Vote: All were in favor; the motion carried.

#### Treasurer's Report:

The utility figures were lower than expected. \$1081.22 was approved; however, \$858.66 was charged. The city said "not to worry about it" and that the bill has already been paid.

- -Motion: Frank made a motion to accept the treasurer's report and closely keep track of the following months' bills in order to look out for discrepancies.
- -Second: Darren seconded.
- -Vote: All were in favor; the motion carried.

It was suggested that the policy for public usage of the Maddux Room should be reviewed.

## **Library and Construction Bills:**

We are getting close to the end of the allowed budget for buying materials.

- -Motion: Darren made a motion to pay the library bills and review them with Christi.
- -Second: Frank seconded.
- -Vote: All were in favor; the motion carried.

The board discussed the faulty electrical outlet on the building exterior, which accounted for the Rakers Electric expense on the project bills.

- -Motion: Frank made a motion to pay the library project bills out of the Maddux Trust.
- -Second: Jane seconded.
- -Vote: All were in favor; the motion carried.

#### Director's Report:

The board reviewed the library director's report, which was included in our handouts in her absence.

Darren talked about the capabilities of the microfilm reader, the demonstration of which was on December 8th. Barb brought up the idea of a touchscreen monitor. Darren said that a touchscreen is one possibility, but it would be unable to be flipped. Barb emphasized that whatever is user friendly should be chosen. The amount of money (\$10,000) has already been approved, so there is plenty of flexibility in choosing the monitor.

The board decided to go along with Christi's recommendations.

Christi mentioned that she had to fill out an incident report on Tuesday, Dec. 29, with three middle-school-aged boys who were playing with the wheeled chairs and, later on, turned on the exterior water faucet. The boys were suspended from the library for a week.

Frank said that he will look into an outside hydrant shut-off control, a way to control the exterior faucet to prevent it from being freely used by anyone on the outside.

The board recommended that the boys' parents should be notified about the faucet incident and the suspension.

Given the extraordinary rain event on Dec. 29th, there was water dripping from the ceiling in the library. Contractors examined the roof and masonry. The problem was traced to some cracks in the stone mortar on the side of the roof joint. Vasquez, the masonry contractor, will fix the mortar when the weather temperature is above 40 degrees Fahrenheit. Frank suggested a water seal that can be applied to masonry to repel water.

At the same time the dripping water was discovered, the main ceiling light fixtures were also affected and were not working. Christi had indicated that the men from the City Electric Department would be looking into the problem.

## **Standing Committee Reports:**

- -Motion: Darren made a motion for a recommendation— not to exceed \$1,000—to work on the microfilm desk and chair.
- -Second: Jane seconded.
- -Vote: All were in favor: the motion carried.

Diversified Landscaping's work is still ongoing; we are waiting until spring to see what they will do about our trees.

Frank will also look into the exterior, faulty outlet after the masonry and light fixtures are fixed. Christi also had mentioned some warped ceiling tiles, which will also be looked into by the Building and Grounds Committee.

### **Public Comment:**

No public.

#### Old Business:

Barb said that a Don Murdoch from O'Fallon will be able to help us with the General Dean video.

#### **New Business:**

- -Motion: Jane made a motion to give Christi authority to buy the microfilm monitor.
- -Second: Frank seconded.
- -Vote: All were in favor; the motion carried.

The Budget Committee Meeting is scheduled for January 14 at 1:30.

- -Motion: Kim made a motion to enter closed session for the Personnel Committee recommendations.
- -Second: Jane seconded.
- -Vote: All were in favor; the motion carried.

The board entered closed session at 8:23 pm.

The board left closed session at 8:40 pm.

- -Motion: Brenda moved that we increase Christi's annual salary by \$1,000, as recommended by the Personnel Committee, and increase the staffs' hourly wage by \$0.10, as recommended by Christi.
- -Second: Jane seconded.
- -Vote: All were in favor; the motion carried.

Adjournment: The next meeting is Feb. 1, 2016.

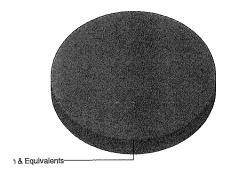
